Already using an on-farm software?

It may be possible to send your flock inventory directly from your software (e.g.: FarmWorks, EweByte, etc) – *Let us know!*

Information to provide

Animal ID, Sire ID, Dam ID, Sex, Date of birth, breed or cross

Your animals are registered through CLRC?

Provide only the registration number and we will use the CLRC website to access all information required.

All your reproductive animals (ewes and rams) must:

- **have a unique identification**
- **be entered in the database prior to recording lamb data**

STEP 3 : RECORD LAMB DATA

Basic lambing data information to record:

Lamb ID, Dam ID, Sire ID, Date of birth, Sex, Number born, Number weaned, Disposal date (deaths, etc.)

All lambs could be weighed on the same date for the 50 and 100-day weights.

Basic weight information recorded to obtain genetic values:

Birth weight, 50 day weight, 100 day weight

To plan your weighing, contact Amelie or consult "Set up your group"

STEP 4 : ENJOY YOUR GENETIC EVALUATION

New genetic evaluations available every Sunday morning
genetic calculations are done every week

Many reports are available at **any time** on your **personal account**
*Flock inventory report, Lamb report, Individual certificate,
