- For the option 2 : Sign and respect the conditions of the genetic service contract. This contract includes a visit by a CEPOQ genetic team ressource and a free access to GenOvis online program.
- -Allow the publication of genetic information for all animals in the flock with genetic indexes (GAIN, CARC, MAT, MAT-U, MAT-HP, MAT-UHP) in the top 50% for their breed.
- -Send real and accurate data.
- -Allow access to the genetic values of your entire flock to estimate the genetic values of the offspring in the GenOvis' mating module.
- -Allow publication of your name, address, contact information, breeds and # of animals tested in all publications concerning the GenOvis Program, as well as both the CEPOQ and GenOvis websites.
- -Volunteer the use of your data for use in related studies and research projects.

Data will be supplied anonymously with no financial compensation.

- -Possess and use an accurate weighing scale suitable for sheep. (Calibration service offered by CEPOQ. Fees apply.)
- -Pay the annual enrolment fee of \$297 + taxes for 2025 (see Section 6)

The CEPOQ is not responsible for the quality of the breeder's raw data submitted for the EPDs and calculation of the indexes.
